Dear Parent/Guardian:

Children need healthy meals to learn. **Immanuel Lutheran High School** offers healthy meals every school day. Breakfast costs **\$2.00**; lunch costs **\$3.00**. Your children may qualify for free meals or for reduced price meals. Reduced price is **\$.30** for breakfast and **\$.40** for lunch.

To apply for free or reduced price meals, use the Free and Reduced Price School Meals Application, which is enclosed. We cannot approve an application that is incomplete, so be sure to fill out all required information on both sides of the application. **Return the completed application to: Immanuel Lutheran High School, 501 Grover Rd., Eau Claire, WI 54701, Attn: ILHS Lunch Applications.**

Here are answers to questions you may have about applying:

- 1. Who can get free or reduced price meals?** Children in households getting Food Stamps or W-2 and most foster children can get free meals regardless of your income. Also, if your household income is within the limits on the Federal Income Chart (see back side of the application) your children can get free or reduced price meals.
- 2. Will the information I give be checked?** Yes, we may ask you to send written proof of the information that you have provided.
- 3. What if I stop getting Food Stamps or W-2?** If your children qualify because you listed a Food Stamp or W-2 case number, you must tell the school when you no longer get Food Stamps or W-2.
- 4. What if my household size or income changes?** If your children qualify for free or reduced price meals at anytime during the school year, your children qualify for the entire school year. You no longer have to report if your household size goes down or if your income goes up by more than \$50 per month (\$600 per year).
- 5. If I don't qualify now, may I apply again later?** Yes. You may apply at any time during the school year if your household size goes up, income goes down, or if you start getting Food Stamps or W-2. If you lose your job, your children may be able to get free or reduced price meals during the time you are unemployed.
- 6. What if I disagree with the school's decision about my application?** You should contact to the high school Principal, Prof. Jeff Schierenbeck.
